



## Alonzo "Peter" Watson Jr.

November 27, 1949 - October 10, 2020

On November 27, 1949, a baby boy was the "first child" born to Alonzo & Pearlina Watson, Sr. He was named Alonzo Isaac Watson, Jr., and he would be the eldest of eventually ten children. Alonzo Jr. a.k.a. Peter, grew up in Waller, Texas. He attended Prairie View Training School and transferred to Waller High School after forced integration in the County.

Peter worked hauling hay throughout Waller County, and worked in restaurants with his Mother. He also worked for Gulf Coast Rice Mill & P&S Rice Mill in Jersey Village, Coca Cola Bottling Company, and at Prairie View A&M University Power Plant with his Father and brothers, Aaron and Ralph.

Peter is preceded in death by his Parents, Grandparents, two Sisters, Lonzone Denise and Otelia Ann, and one Brother, Herbert Emory. He is also preceded in death by his nephew, Patrick Crawford and several Aunts, Uncles, Cousins, and In-laws.

Alonzo Jr. leaves to cherish his memories 4 Brothers, Larry James (Cathy), Kenneth Earl, Aaron Carl (Jean), and Ralph Lloyd; two Sisters, Mary Elizabeth and Sandra Gayle. Others that
