On various occasions, I would visit his home in Chappell Hill for target practice behind the house at the pond. When I visited, he would always ask, “Did you get the scope right?” I had a brand-new weapon and had not scoped it in, missing the targets—something he would not let me forget.

Despite his pleasant demeanor, Floyd was tenacious regarding Texas A&M Aggies football.

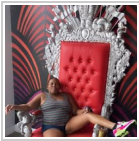
