James Edward Page, 70, died Monday, March 13, 2017 at his residence in Hempstead, after a valiant battle with cancer.

He leaves his wife Brendella and their two daughters, Jasmine and Jalyn; daughters Kimberly Saatkamp (Michael) of Salem, IL and Jeana Bouser (Ethan) of Farina, IL, from a previous marriage; nine grandchildren; one great-grandchild.

Born and raised in Pontiac, IL, the son of Edward James Page and Lois Louise Page (Mason) both deceased. Two brothers and four sisters survive him. He was a long time resident of the Hempstead area.
