Ora Hill-Wallace was born on July 18, 1940, in Eudora Arkansas. During the first years of her life, Ora was raised in Greenville, Mississippi and Eudora, Arkansas. She moved to Bellville, Texas in 1957 with her mother, Berniece Madison, where they attended Allen Chapel A.M.E. Church.

Ora attended Austin County High School in Sealy, Texas. After graduating high school, and beginning her family, Ora took educational courses through the Job Training Program, (JTPA) in Prairie View, Texas. She worked numerous jobs simultaneously to support her children whom she loved dearly. She was employed at Prairie View A&M University as a clerk in the Fiscal Office and custodial staff before her retirement from the State of Texas for more than 20 years.

Ora was a faithful member of Morning Star Missionary Baptist Church where her oldest son, Anthony Hill was her Pastor for many years. She later joined Mount Corinth Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Clarence Talley. Ora enjoyed attending her Sunday School classes and was a very participative member during the studies. While she missed attending services in person due to the pandemic, she mastered listening to services via Zoom.

Ora was a woman of compassion, who loved her children dearly. She gave

without measure to her grandchildren and great grandchildren. Ora loved to cook and share her many recipes. She also enjoyed sharing different life skills with them.

Ora made her transition from this earthly life to eternal rest on Tuesday, February 23, 2021. She is preceded in death by her parents and her husband, Robert L. Wallace, Jr.

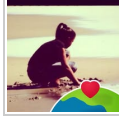
